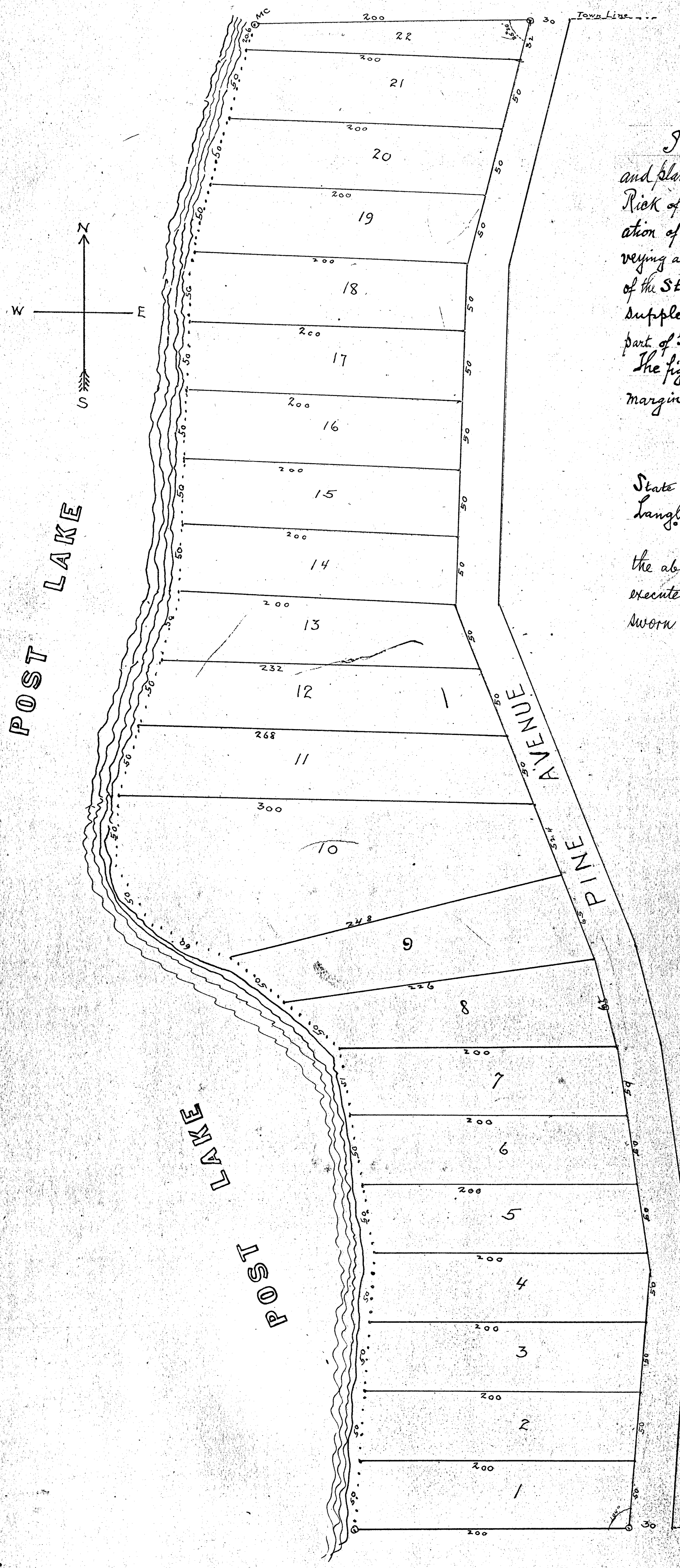


RICK AND BLOCK PARK
