I, Alex Deleglise, Surveyor do hereby certify that by order and direction of Thos Morrissey, Sec and Treas of the Catholic Cemetery Association of Antigo Wis, that I have surveyed and mapped in full compliance with Ciro of the Statutes of 1905, a part of the North half of the South East Quarter of Section Twenty-Nine of Township Thirty-one N. of Range Eleven E. Langlade County, Wisconsin, described as follows: Commencing at a point on the East line of Aurora Street of the City of Antigo, Wis and One Hundred and sixty five south of the center line of Sixth Avenue of said City, running thence North on said East line of Aurora Street Three Hundred and thirty feet thence East Six Hundred and sixty feet, thence South Three Hundred and thirty feet, thence West Six Hundred and sixty feet to the place of beginning.

That the accompanying map and the notes and figures thereon is a correct representation of all the exterior boundaries of the land above described and the subdivisions therein made and made for cemetery purposes, that the small dots at corners and at ends of curves; thus o, are where I have placed 2" x 20" iron pipe. 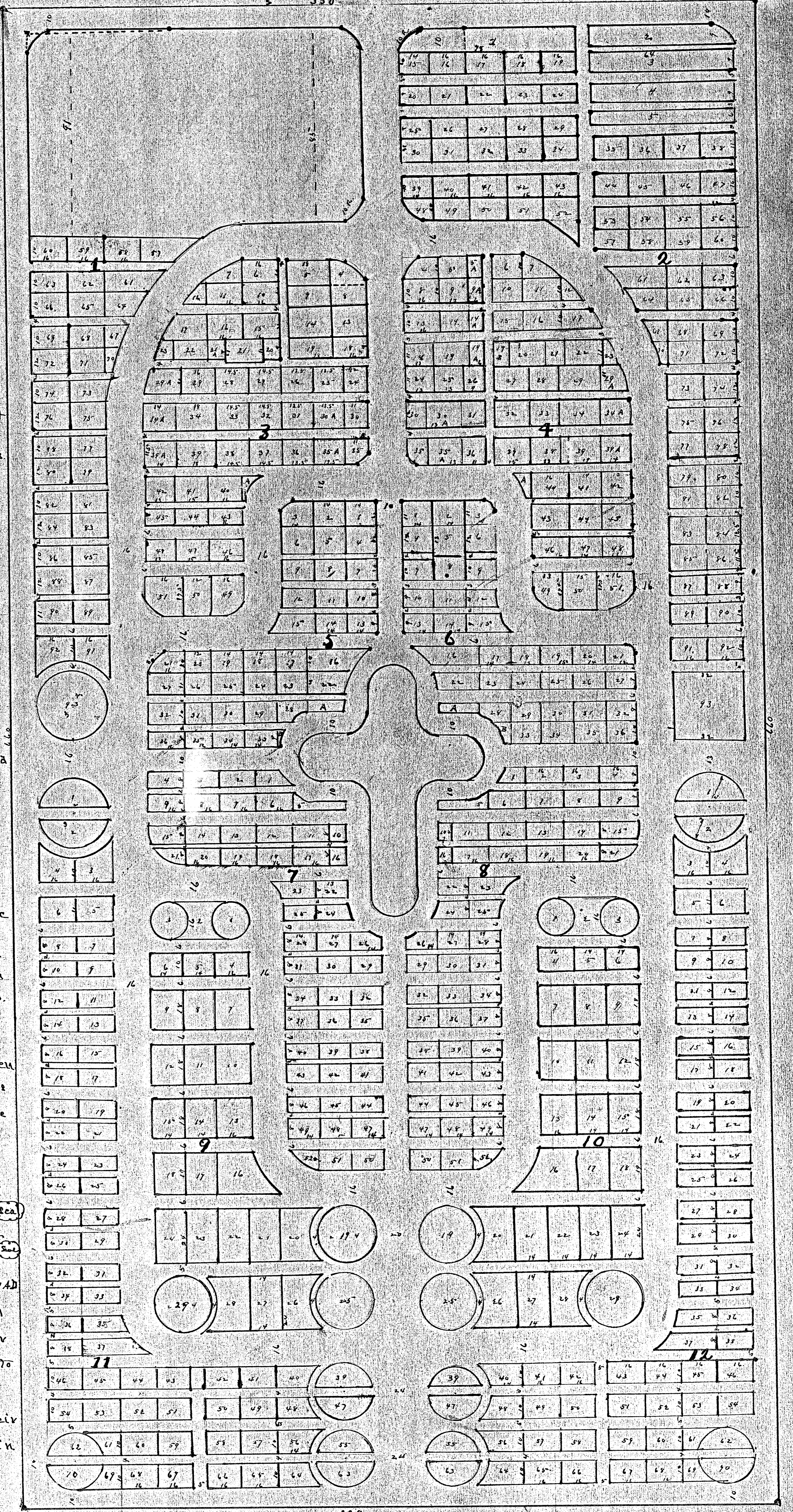
