Surveyor's Certificate.

I hereby certify that I have surveyed subdivided and plotted the land represented by the within map, by direction and authority of myself; and that said map is a correct representation of all the boundaries of the land surveyed, and the divisions thereon made; and that the land intended to be included in this plat, is such part of the N. 1/2 of the N. E. 1/4 of Section 13, in Township 34 North; of Range 10 East, as is shown on said map; and that in surveying and subdividing same I have fully complied with Chapter CL of the Revised Statutes of Wisconsin, of 1876.

The streets are 60 ft. wide - measuring parallel to, or at right angles with the R.R. Right of Way - Lake St. and Antigo St., which are each 66 ft. wide, and Elk St. which is 33 ft. wide, and Cole St. which is 30 ft. wide.

The alleys are 20 ft. wide - measuring at right angles with the R.R. of W. The large figures placed near the centers of the blocks indicate the numbers of the blocks, and the smaller figures placed near the centers of the lots, indicate the numbers of the lots. The figures placed near lines, show the lengths of the lines near which they are placed.

At the N.E. corner of said Section 13, is set a granite boulder 6' x 8' x 30" with a + on top, and broken dishes under it. At the S.E. corner of said N. 1/2 N. E. 1/4 Sec. 13, is set a granite boulder 6' x 6' x 30" with a + on top and broken dishes under it.

At the center of the said N. E. 1/4 Sec. 13, is set the end of an axle-tree with a cast-iron shackle on it. This map is drawn to a scale of 100 ft. to the inch.

The center line of the Milwaukee Lake Shore Western Railway Company is the base line from which all measurements East and West were made.

The angle between said line and the south line of the Plat is $90^{\circ} \pm 8'' - 10''$. Given under my hand at Antigo Wis. this 12th of February 1897.
